What are some common types of phone scams?

- Bank **scams**. Someone may call claiming to be from your bank telling you there's a problem with your card or account. ...
- Computer repair **scams**. ...
- Compensation calls. ...
- HMRC **scams**. ...
- Number spoofing. ... using what looks like a familiar no. but isn't.
- Pensions and investment **scams**. ...
- 'Anti-scam' **scams**.

Your bank or credit card company will never ask you for personal details or Pins over the phone, so you should never give it out even if you think that the caller is legitimate.

Be careful yourself and warn elderly and vulnerable friends and neighbours always to be on their guard and never to give personal or financial details over the phone to callers no matter how plausible their story seems.
