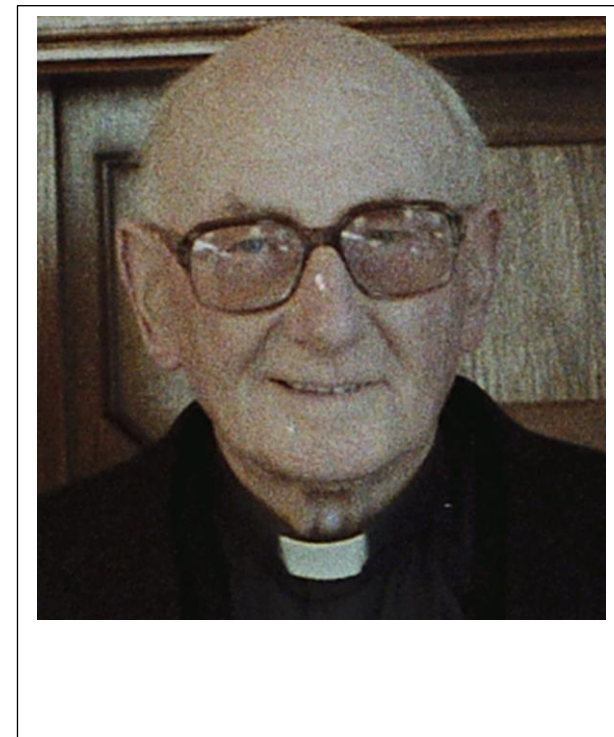

It would seem back in 1901 and 1910 it was customary that local police officers were the people who conducted the Census. The Hugh Esler above was a police officer and resident of Ballynahinch. He was also the father of the late **Archdeacon Hugh Esler** who was a priest in the Diocese of Dromore and died in Warrenpoint in 1983. Canon Esler also served as administrator in Newry and it was while there that he and others set about creating what is now called **“Páirc Esler”** as the home for Down GAA matches.
